Wyong Drama Group last produced *Fawlty Towers* in April 2006 and it was then also directed by Pam. This time, we will be presenting three different episodes of the show. Given that there were only twelve *Fawlty Towers* ever made, this means that the drama group will have presented half of the entire series in the last three years.

*Fawlty Towers* always proves to be a very popular show for all amateur theatre groups. Back in 2006 we had several full houses for some session times, so this year we are offering an extra matinee on the first Sunday of the usual two week run.

The cast includes quite a few actors from the 2006 show, and includes many actors regular WDG audiences will know well, such as Howard Oxley, Laszlo Weidlich, Cathy DeVries, Kelly Humphries, Marc Calwell, Pollyanna Forshaw, and John Czerniecki.

As usual the show will be performed at Wyong Memorial Hall in Anzac Avenue, Wyong opening on Thursday 13 August at 8pm. There are then eight more shows, Friday 14<sup>th</sup> at 8pm, Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> at 2pm and 8pm, Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> at 2pm, Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> at 8pm, Friday 21<sup>st</sup> at 8pm Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> at 2pm and closing night on 22<sup>nd</sup> August at 8pm. The cost is \$17 for the Thursday nights and Matinees, and \$20 on Friday and Saturday nights.
