She has played in practically every West-End Theatre in London, played three seasons at the Old Vic, one with Laurence Olivier, two seasons at Stratford-on-Avon, has done two American and Canadian tours with the last named. During the thirties she ran her own Theatre for seven years and has many famous people working under her, i.e. Rex Harrison, Roger Livesey, Margaret Rutherford and many others. She came to Australia to play the lead in "Sailor Beware", and liked the country so much that her husband joined her and they have made their home here. She teaches, plays and produces for Miss Doris Fitton at the Independent Theatre in Sydney, where her husband David Burney is the manager of the Dramatic School. This year they are to adjudicate the Silver Jubilee of the Sydney Eisteddford together
