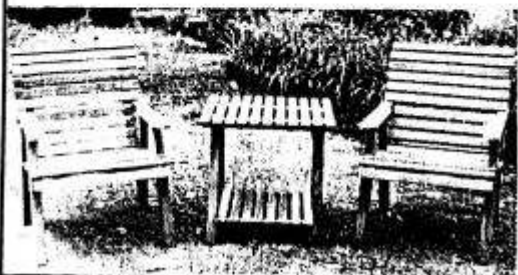

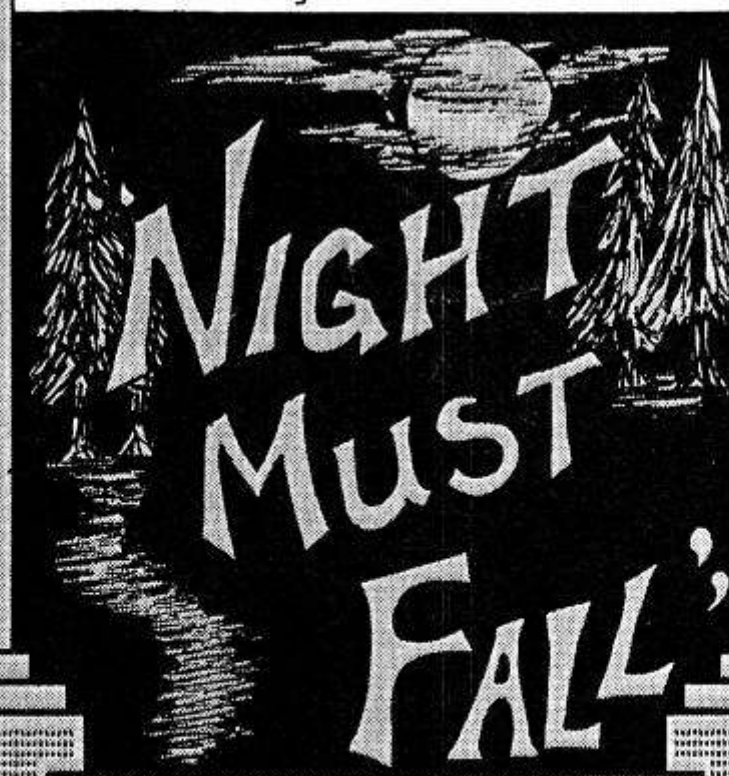

## *Players*

### **ADRIAN ADAM**

Last seen as the lead in a superb production of "Look Back in Anger", Adrian is one of the coast's most dynamic young performers. In recent months he has twice taken out the coveted Best Actor award at State-wide drama festivals.

### **WYN ARMSTRONG**

A skilled actress, Wyn came to Wyong Drama Group two years ago, after working with Cronulla Arts Theatre. Our regular patrons will recall her, complete with enormous false nose, as the testy housekeeper Mrs Darcy in "Brush With A Body".

### **ROB BAXTER**

In his fourteen months with Wyong Drama Group, Rob has chalked up some excellent comedy performances. Most notably as the frantic bank clerk in "No Sex Please - We're British". This is his first role in a dramatic thriller.

### **SALLY-ANN BAXTER**

Sally-Ann made her acting debut last year in the small but demanding role Marge in "Home Fires Burning". Though a relative newcomer to the theatrical stage, she is no stranger to performing, having sung in a folk band with husband, Rob.

### **JULIE BAILEY**
