RAY NOONAN This is Ray's third show as Director, the previous two being "Boeing Boeing" for Wyong Drama Group and "Wait Until Dark" for Gosford Players. Ray enjoys mixing direction with on stage performances, being seen in WDG's "The One Day of the Year".



TRACY ROWE Tracy is a relative newcomer to W.D.G. first appearing as Cynthia Dimey in "The Walking Stick of The Desert". She first discovered her talent for "hamming it up" whilst practicing on a young captive audience who could not move, (in other words Tracy is a pre-school teacher). Local audiences will undoubtedly see more of Tracy as time goes by.

LASZLO WEIDLICH Laszlo was last seen briefly as the "Mad Mullah" in "The Walking Stick of the Desert". Previous to this he had the lead role as Alf "I'm a bloody Australian" Cook in "The One Day of the Year". That lead role was the culmination of several other shows for W.D.G. starting with "This Fractured Century". His ambition is to play Count Dracula in a Dungeon Theatre in his ancestral Transylvania.



ROBYN BYLES Robyn's first few performances were with the Bathurst Players where she performed in various plays including "Don't Just Lie There, Say Something", "Black Comedy" and "Not Now Darling". Since coming to W.D.G. she has played the mother in "Kid Stakes", the mother again in "Brush With a Body", and now moves into the vastly different, saucy role of Yvonne. Robyn is thoroughly enjoying her switch in character.

HOWARD OXLEY Howard has been with the Drama Group for quite some time and appeared in a whole host of productions, mostly in comedy roles. He has been a keen President for W.D.G. for the past two years and is delighted to see the group turning out quality amateur productions and winning awards for achievement at State Theatre Festivals. Howard has also tried his hand at Directing being a Co-Director of "Brush With a Body" for W.D.G. last year.



PETER KOGAN Peter is a man who prefers not to discuss what he has done but let the audience make up their own mind from his performances. He has appeared in many productions for W.D.G. including several plays he also wrote.



LISA CASSON Welcome back Lisa! This is Lisa's first role back after a lengthy break from Theatre. Her last role was in "Boeing Boeing" for W.D.G. in 1988. Prior to that her list of credits were too numerous to list in this short space.

JIM DOBBYN Jim is widely known for his performances in musicals for The Entrance Theatre Co ("West Side Story" in 1985), Youtheatre and more recently Gosford Musical Society ("Paint Your Wagon" and Showboat"). This is his second appearance in a play, the first being "Wait Until Dark" for Gosford Players last year. All groups have benefited from Jim's expertise as a Set Designer and Builder with him having designed and/or constructed sets for most shows he has been involved in. This is Jim's first on stage role for Wyong Drama Group and he's enjoying it immensely.



BARBARA OLIVER Barbara is another relative newcomer to W.D.G. coming in to work as prompt on "Brush With a Body" last year. She is proving to be very adaptable and really launches herself into shows she becomes involved with. The Director of this show would like to personally thank Barbara for all her dedication, hard work and most of all her patience during this production.

JULIE BAILEY Julie has been involved with different amateur theatre groups for 21 years and averages one performance for each of those years. She has also tried her hand at Stage Management, Publicity and even Direction but her greatest love is being part of a cohesive acting team. Her most satisfying acting role in recent years was that of the mother in "The One Day of the Year".

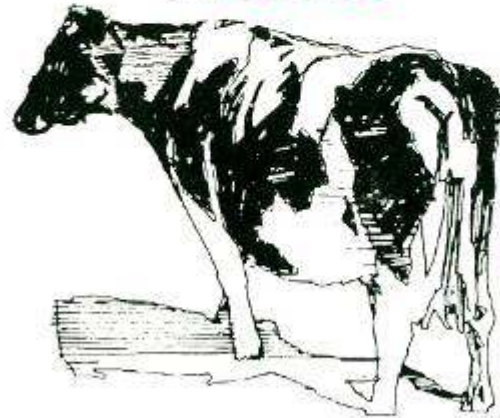
