Frances (Kelly Humphries) and Peter (Stephen McDonald) are newly weds, living in a flat above the bank where Peter has just been promoted to Manager. They have recently returned from their honeymoon to find that Peter's mother Eleanor (Jeanette McCurry) has decided to come and stay "only for a day or two". Add the Senior Bank Manager Leslie Bromhead (Laszlo Weidlich) who has been invited to dinner at the insistence of Eleanor; some mistaken wedding gifts (or are they?); the fumbling, ever-so-helpful Brian Runnicles (Duncan Mitchell); two ladies of the night (Jenny Sharrock and Sally Bartley) some and unexpected visits from Superintendent Paul (Barry Sampson) and you have all the ingredients for an hilarious, fun night out.

When the show opened in London in the early 1970s it broke all box-office records and ran for ages. Wyong Drama Group last performed the play in April 1991, a testament to its durability as the group doesn't repeat shows unless they have proven to be definite audience-pleasers.

As usual the show will be performed at Wyong Memorial Hall in Anzac Avenue, Wyong opening on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> November at 8pm. There are then seven more shows, Friday 6<sup>th</sup> at 8pm, Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> at 2pm and 8pm, Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> at 8pm, Friday 13<sup>th</sup> at 8pm Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> at 2pm and closing night on 14<sup>th</sup> November at 8pm. The cost is \$17 for the Thursday nights and Saturday Matinees, and \$20 on the Friday and Saturday nights.
