Due to the popularity of Wyong Drama Group's production of ***No Sex Please-We're British*** opening in November this year, an extra show has been scheduled. Originally eight shows were planned, opening on Thursday 5th November at 8pm then Friday 6th at 8pm, Saturday 7th at 2pm and 8pm, Thursday 12th at 8pm, Friday 13th at 8pm Saturday 14th at 2pm and closing night on 14th November at 8pm. On Sunday 8th November, an additional matinee has been scheduled for 2pm.

This extra matinee is not on the printed flyers the group mailed out a few weeks ago, so they are asking patrons to help spread the news about the extra show. There have been hundreds of bookings already accepted for the two Saturday Matinees, so this Sunday matinee will hopefully cater for the unprecedented demand.

The play is one of the longest running shows on London's West End and Broadway, and was made into a movie in 1973 starring Ronnie Corbett (*The Two Ronnies*) and Arthur Lowe (*Dad's Army*).

The farce is about an assistant bank manager, Peter Hunter, who lives above his bank with his new bride Frances. When Frances innocently sends a mail order off for some Scandinavian glassware, what comes back is Scandinavian pornography. The two, along with the bank's frantic chief cashier Brian Runnicles, must decide what to do with the veritable floods of pornography, photographs, books, films and eventually girls that threaten to engulf this happy couple.

Wyong Drama Group's production is directed by Millie Sampson and the cast includes Laszlo Weidlich (Leslie Bromhead), Duncan Mitchell (Brian Runnicles), Kelly Humphries (Frances Hunter) and Stephen McDonald (Peter Hunter) to name just a few.

As usual the show will be performed at Wyong Memorial Hall in Anzac Avenue, Wyong. The cost is \$17 for the Thursday nights and Matinees, and \$20 on Friday and Saturday nights.
