No Sex Please, We're British is your typical British farce written by Alistair Foot & Anthony Marriott. The show tells what happens when deliveries of material of (how shall we put it?) a sexually explicit nature are made to the flat of the newlyweds Peter (Stephen McDonald) and Frances (Kelly Humphries). Peter just happens to work for a bank, and lives in a flat directly over it. He's eager to maintain his new promotion by giving a good impression to his bosses at the bank, but with this sort of material arriving all the time, well, he's up against it.

To make matters worse, his mother-in-law (Jeanette McCurry) is visiting: staying for longer than originally expected, and even seeming to charm the bank manager (Laszlo Weidlich) who is warning of an impending snap audit to be carried out by the district inspector (John Wright). It's hard work for Peter who has enlisted the help of his well-meaning but confused colleague Brian (Duncan Mitchell) to dispose of the material and keep things on an even keel. The cast also includes Barry Sampson, Sally Bartley, Jenny Sharrock and Les Besseney. It is directed by Millie Sampson.

The show is proving quite popular; so much so that an additional matinee has been arranged for Sunday 8 November at 2pm. This show was added after the bookings for the Saturday matinees meant WDG was looking at house-full signs for these two performances. There are plenty of tickets left for all the other shows, however, and the group can squeeze a few more into the Saturday matinees if you book very quickly. A great way to enjoy the show is to bring a few friends, some nibblies and drinks, and see the show from a table. There is also raised seating on platforms toward the rear of the hall offering an excellent view of the stage.
